He is also the Member of the Subject Expert Committee on Mathematical Sciences under FIST Program and Vice President of the Governing Body of Institute of Human Behaviors and Allied Sciences.

Professor Dinesh Singh obtained his Bachelors and Masters in Mathematics from St.Stephen's College, University of Delhi and his M.Phil from the University of Delhi. He obtained his Ph.D degree from the Imperial College of Science, Technology and Medicine, London. He has published numerous research papers in international and national journals and his research work has been cited in several books and articles.
