Dr. Kimberly Matheson was appointed Vice-President (Research and International) in November 2009. She joined the Department of Psychology at Carleton University in 1990 as a SSHRC Canada Research Fellow, and was promoted to Full Professor in 2003.

She is a highly accomplished researcher and graduate supervisor, and is widely published in the areas of Social and Health Psychology. She was the Acting Vice-President (Research and International) at Carleton University from 2007-09, and as Chair of the Department of Psychology from 1997 until 2003, she presided over the largest academic unit at the University. She has served on University Senate, the Senate Financial Review Committee, and was a member of the University Task Force on Planning and Priorities.

She is currently a member of the Advisory Board for the Social Interactions, Identity, and Well-being Panel of the Canadian Institutes for Advanced Research, and is on the Scientific Board of the Institute of Mental Health Research at the Royal Ottawa Hospital.

She received her Ph.D. in 1988 from the University of Waterloo and is a Carleton alumna (B.A. Hons/82, M.A./83).
